No Excuses University is based on the idea of college readiness—"Every student deserves the opportunity to be educated in a way that prepares them for college, if they so choose to attend." "Six Exceptional Systems" help schools focus on the most important part of a school—learning and better results for students' education. No Excuses! No Limits!

A Culture of Universal Achievement: When everyone at a school believes that all students can learn, no matter what! At NWE, staff members have created beliefs and norms and have one goal: Every student will be performing at or above grade level in all subject areas. We believe...

~every student will be proficient in all subject areas, including life skills such as respect for themselves and others.

Student growth is the key to proficiency, and in order to support this, staff members must collaborate with one another to help all students.

~student effort is driven by our expectations, example & excitement.

~students' challenges in life do not define who they will become. These challenges are simply stepping stones to success.

It is our job to create positive relationships with students and their families. Challenges will not interfere with our high expectations; expectations will be fair for all students.

~consistent collaboration among staff members, and with students/families, is critical to student and school success.

Collaboration should happen on a daily basis through formal structures, as well as informally with students at the heart of our work.

~high expectations will be set for students, staff, and parents, with permission to fail while taking academic risks, support for persevering and showing grit, and opportunities to learn while never giving up—no matter what—No Excuses!

Collaboration: Teachers and other staff members work together in an effort to prepare students for college. At NWE, teachers engage in weekly math planning with the math specialist. Staff members also participate in planning family engagement events, grade levels meet on a weekly basis to discuss student learning, and data meetings take place with specialists, administration and classroom teachers to focus on teaching and learning.

Standards Alignment: Teachers plan their lessons using the correct grade level standards for the area(s) they teach. At NWE, teachers use AZ College and Career Readiness standards as a guide for all they do.

Assessment Plan: Teachers plan common assessments that align to the standards. Successful common assessments will show teachers if students have mastered the standards. Teachers can then adjust their lessons as necessary. At NWE, teachers have been and continue to engage in trainings that help them analyze data and provide them with new strategies for lessons and interventions.

Data Analysis: Data should be the language of any NEU school. Teachers analyze data to plan for interventions and daily lessons. At NWE, teachers use data to plan for instruction during weekly math planning, weekly grade level meetings, and monthly data meetings.

Interventions: Data is used to plan interventions. Interventions provide teachers with data regarding the effectiveness of an intervention. At NWE, all students engage in interventions/enrichment 4-5 days/week for Reading or Mathematics.

An important part of being a No Excuses University school is that everyone makes a pledge to give their best effort to help send NWE students to college. A 3-way pledge is introduced every academic year. Students, parents, and teachers are asked to sign it as a way to bring the conversation of helping to support students to be college bound. Part of the staff pledge is that: We are committed to providing extraordinary educational opportunities to every learner.

Teachers Pledge to:

- * Teach state standards
- *Communicate regularly with parents
- *Strive to meet the individual needs of each student

Students Pledge to :

- *Arrive to school every day, on time unless they are ill
- *Follow the school rule
- *Complete and turn in assignments
- *Share letters, corrected work, and other school information with parents

Parents Pledge to:

- *Ensure that their child(ren) attend school every day, on time, unless they are ill
- *Practice and use the Take 5 commitment
- *Look at communication from school-corrected work, fliers, letters

What is the Parent Take 5 Pledge? - We ask that parents take 5 minutes each day to talk to their child(ren) about their day, asking them the "Take Five" questions.

No excusas! No Limites!

Una Cultura de Logro Universal: cuando todos en una escuela creen que todos los estudiantes pueden aprender, sin importar nada! En NWE, los miembros del personal han creado creencias y normas y tienen un objetivo: cada estudiante se estará desempeñando a nivel de grado o superior

Nivel en toda las áreas temáticas. Nosotros creemos...

- ~Cada estudiante será competente en todas las áreas temáticas, incluyendo habilidades para la vida como el respeto por ellos mismos y por los demás. El crecimiento del estudiante es la clave del dominio, y para apoyar esto, los miembros del personal deben colaborar entre sí para ayudar a todos los estudiantes.
- ~ el esfuerzo del estudiante es impulsado por nuestras expectativas, ejemplo y emoción.
- ~los desafíos del estudiante en la vida no define en quien se convertirán. Estos desafíos son simplemente escalones para el éxito. Es nuestro trabajo crear una relación positiva con nuestros estudiantes y sus familias. Los desafíos no interfieran con nuestras altas expectativas; Expectativas serán justas para todos nuestros estudiantes.
- ~Colaboración consistente entre los miembros del personal, y con estudiantes/familias, es crítico para el éxito de los estudiantes y la escuela. Colaboración debe suceder a diario a través de la estructura formal, así como de manera informal con los estudiantes en el corazón de nuestro trabajo.
- ~ Altas expectativas serán establecidas para los estudiantes, personal, y padres, con permiso de fallar mientras asumes riesgos académicos, apoyo para perseverar y demostrar valentía, y oportunidades para aprender mientras nunca te rindas — sin importar nada — No Excusas!

Colaboración: Maestros y otros miembros del personal trabajan juntos en un esfuerzo por preparar a los estudiantes para la universidad. En NEU, los maestros participan en la planificación semanal de matemáticas con el especialista en matemáticas. Los miembros del personal también participan en la planificación de eventos de participación familiar; el nivel de grado se reúne semanalmente para discutir el aprendizaje de los estudiantes, y las reuniones de datos se llevan a cabo con especialistas, administración y maestros para enfocarse en la enseñanza y el aprendizaje.

Alineación de Estándares: Los maestros planean sus lecciones usando los estándares correcto de nivel de grado para las área(s) que enseñan. En NWE, usan AZ universidad y estándares de preparación profesional como una guía para todo lo que hacen.

Plan de Evaluación: los maestros planifican evaluaciones comunes que se alinean con los estándares. Las evaluaciones comunes exitosas mostraran a los maestros si los estudiantes han dominado los estándares. Los maestros pueden ajustar sus lecciones según sea necesario. En NWE, los maestros han participado y siguen participando en capacitaciones que los ayudan a analizar datos y brindarles nuevas estrategias para lecciones e intervenciones.

Análisis de los Datos: Los datos debería de ser el lenguaje de cualquier escuela NEU. Los maestros analizan los datos para planear las intervenciones lecciones diarias. En NWE, los maestros usan los datos para planificar la instrucción durante la planificación semanal de matemáticas, las reuniones semanal de nivel de grado y las reuniones de datos mensuales.

Intervenciones: los datos son usados para planificar intervenciones. Las intervenciones proporcionan a los maestros datos sobre la efectividad de una intervención. En NWE, todos los estudiantes participan en intervenciones/ enriquecimiento de 4 a 5 días/semana para lectura o matemáticas.

Una parte importante de ser una escuela de No Excusas Universidad todos se comprometen en hacer su mejor esfuerzo para ayudar a enviar a los estudiantes de NWE a la universidad. Una promesa de 3-vías se presenta cada año académico. Estudiantes, padres, y maestros se les pedirá que lo firmen como una forma de llevar la conversación de ayuda a apoyar a los estudiantes a que se unan a la universidad. Parte de la promesa del personal es que: estamos comprometidos a brindar oportunidades de educación extraordinarias a cada alumno.

Los Maestros se Comprometen a:

- *Enseñar los estándares estatales
- *Comunicarse regularmente con los padres
- *Esforzarse por cumplir con las necesidades individuales de cada estudiante

Los Estudiantes se Comprometen a:

- *Llegar a la escuela todos los días, a tiempo al menos que estén enfermos
- *Seguir las reglas de la escuela
- *Completar y entregar las tareas
- *Compartir cartas, trabajo corregido, y otra información escolar con los padres

Los Parents se Comprometen a:

- *Asegurarse de que su hijo(os) asista a la escuela todos los días, a tiempo, al menos que estén enfermos
- *Practicar y usar el compromiso de Toma 5
- *Mirar la comunicación de la escuela-trabajo corregido, volantes, cartas

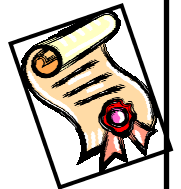

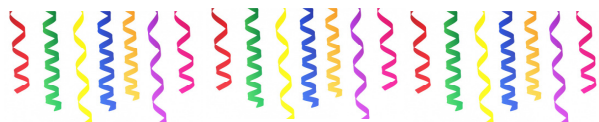
